

Functions of the Michigan ITC Health Services Division

1. Provide technical assistance, consultation for Tribal Health and Services systems development, maintenance and or expansion.
2. To respond to Resource Development needs of the Tribes.
3. Advocacy, networking, liaison.
4. Training and Education.
5. Quality Assurance Programming.
6. Community Health Assessment and Profiling – through management of data collection and analysis system.
7. Communication – Federal, State and Local initiatives.
8. Respond to the Health Promotion/Disease Prevention Planning and Programming needs of the Tribes.
9. Delivery of Comprehensive Environmental Programs.
10. Other – As defined by Tribes, individually or collectively.
