

## **Objectives of the Michigan ITC Health Services Division**

### **Objective #1:**

To promote the planning and deliver of the Health Promotion/Disease Prevention Programs using the Healthy People 2010 Objectives, particularly those that impact the health status of Indian people.

### **Objective #2:**

Promote, develop and deliver a comprehensive environmental health program designed to assist Indian families and communities to identify and correct environmental conditions detrimental to their health status of the community in general.

### **Objective #3:**

Promote and assist in the development and delivery of chronic disease prevention programs particularly diabetes, cancer, cardiovascular disease and hypertension.

### **Objective #4:**

Promote and assist in the development and delivery or comprehensive maternal and child health services that ensure healthily moms and healthy babies.

### **Objective #5:**

Promote and assist in the development and delivery of training and education programs that increase the skills of Health and Human Services workers who provide services and training to Indian people that enhance, maintain and expand the capability of current Tribal Health Programs.

### **Objective #6:**

To function as advocates for Tribes, relative to their Tribal sovereign status, promote P.L. 93-638 and 94-437 (i.e., the Indian Self-Determination Act and the Indian Health Care Improvement Act).

### **Objective #7:**

To promote and assist in strategic Health and Human Services program planning and evaluation through total Quality Management, Quality Assurance, technical assistance/consultation.

### **Objective #8:**

To promote and assist in MITC/Tribal Resource Development and communications efforts for the purpose of Tribal Health Systems enhancement.
