

# What kinds of activities are good to do during a PICCOLO observation?



Reading together picture books with or without words



Playing with Manipulative toys (puzzles, blocks, shape sorter), playdough or art supplies

Pretend play using toys (examples - cash register with toy foods, kitchen set, doll or stuffed animal, toy cars)

Doing a typical family routine (example - eating a meal, cleaning up, brushing teeth)

Planned home visit activities that involve the parent and child interacting together (example-Gikinawaabi lesson)

**Suggested Activities: should be done wherever the family is comfortable, engage the parent and child, and last a least 10 minutes.**
